The destination offers a variety of restaurants and bars to explore. A curious, craveable, walk-up window offering classic Poutine and the closest thing to a street food vendor in Franklinton.

### **The Back Patio**

The Back Patio is a magnetic gathering hub for hotel guests and Columbus locals, featuring an open fireplace providing social warmth and comfort. There is a seamless overflow of engagement from The Trade Room and interior bar as this space allows for a number of vignettes available to guests and locals alike.

### The Trade Room
